The Education in Palliative and End-of-life Care (EPEC) program, founded in 1999, uses a high-impact, high-dissemination curriculum to spread palliative care competencies to health care providers across the United States and the world. EPEC's unique design transforms participants into certified EPEC Trainers who are empowered to implement effective palliative care practices at their home institutions and teach others to do the same. More than 2,500 EPEC Trainers in the US and 25 countries abroad teach the EPEC curriculum in its many forms including EPEC-Core, EPEC-Oncology, EPEC-Emergency Medicine, EPEC-Pediatrics, EPEC for Veterans and EPEC-India.

EPEC's 'Become a Trainer' conferences focus on the acquisition of palliative care competencies and teaching skills, and provide an opportunity to further enhance teaching and leadership skills in Palliative Care.

The EPEC-India curriculum provides a unique opportunity to learn to teach palliative care competencies to colleagues and allows for hands-on practice to train in effective educational techniques to reach adult learners. The program involves case-based teaching, role-play, interactive lecturing, video-based learning and others.

The core objective of EPEC-India "Become a Trainer" Conference is to impart palliative care teaching skills to the practicing palliative care physicians and nurses to enable them to become palliative care trainers and teach others at their institutions.
